This Indenture made and entered into on the seventh day of January in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and twenty nine between Benjamin Jordan deceased Peter Christian Jordan Richard Jordan all of the County of Southampton and State of New York, the husband and wife of the said Benjamin and Peter Christian Joseph Jordan, the said Jordan for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred dollars or an attorney 25th day of December 1830 of this Commonwealth to them in hand by the said Joseph Jordan at or before the date hereof and delivery of these presents in receipt whereof for his receipt acknowledge have granted bargained and sold and by the present they and each of them doth grant bargained and sell also Enjoys and occupies unto the said Joseph Jordan his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of Land situated lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of St. Paul's containing by estimation one hundred and sixty acres and be the same more or less as being the land and plantation wherein the said Joseph Jordan now resides and bounded followeth: Beginning at a Black Gum standing near the sum of the Arthur Swamp a corner for Sally Creek in Lewis Morris' line thence along said Sally Creek's line of marsh trees to a post oak a corner for James Bellay, John Starpore and others lying in said John Starpore's line of marked trees to a Black gum standing in one prong of the said Arthur Swamp a corner for Benjamin Jordan thence along his line to a Black Gum standing near the same line of said Arthur Swamp a corner for said Benjamin Jordan and Lewis Morris' line thence down the sum of said swamp the various courses thereof first starting together with all the houses and houses way waters and water courses and all rights title to claim or demand of in and to the said tract or parcel of land and premises with its appurtenances thereto belonging even any use appertaining to a Slave and to Goldens aforesaid tract or parcel of land and premises with all and singular its appurtenances whatsoever belonging unto him the said Joseph Jordan his heirs and assigns forever to and for his sole use and behoof of him the said Joseph Jordan his heirs and assigns forever and the said Benjamin Jordan, Patience, Dick Christian Jordan and Richard Jordan his children
