 Titus Clerk Christian Jordan Joseph Jordan and Rebecca Jordan his wife
 all of the County of Southampton and state of Virginia of the one part and Richard Jordan
 of the same County and State of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Benjamin
 Jordan Titus Clerk Christian Jordan Joseph Jordan and Rebecca Jordan his
 wife for and in consideration of the sum of Three hundred and fifty dollars current
 Money of this Commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said Richard Jordan at or
 before the entering and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged have granted bargained and sold and by these presents they and each of them
 doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Richard Jordan his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of Land situate lying and
 being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at
 a corner for James and Sarah Dick also a new corner for William Story thence along said
 Josiah Dick's line 290 & 96 poles to a corner thence 225 & 75 poles to a creek oak tree
 224¹/₂ & 88³/₄ poles along the said creek to the Cypress road thence along said road 229 & 69 poles
