This Indenture made and entered into on the 7th day of January in the year one thousand eight hundred and twenty nine between Benjamin Jordan Rebecca Jordan Joseph Jordan and Rebecca Jordan his wife and Richard Jordan all of the County of Jouchampton and state of Virginia of the one part and William Story of the same County and state of the other part Witnesseth that the said Benjamin Jordan Rebecca Jordan Joseph Jordan and Rebecca his wife and Richard Jordan for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred and eighty two dollars and fifty cents current money of the Commonwealth of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said William Story at or before the executing or delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is shown by a bill of exchange here granted bargained and sold and by these presents they and each of them doth grant bargain and sell alien in full and forever unto him the said William Story his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the aforesaid County of Jouchampton and state of Virginia and Parish of St Lukes containing by a late survey ninety acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows To wit Beginning on the Centre of the Coffey's Road a new Corn for the above parties in William's Trick's line a corner for Samuel Story thence along said Story's line of marked oak a 30 pole 6 pole thence N 25° W 10 pole thence N 88° W 12 pole thence at 230° 182° 1/2 pole to a black oak a new Corn for William's Trick's line thence along said William's Trick's line a new Corn for James Trick's line thence along said Trick's line at 182° E 14 pole thence S 26° W 10 pole thence S 27° E 12 pole thence S 29° E 8 pole thence S 27° E 12 pole thence N 29° E 12 pole to a pine a new Corn for Lewis Story thence along said Story's line at 182° E 14 pole to the aforesaid Coffey's road thence up the road at 182° E 6 pole to the first station of a gate with all right and
