This Indenture made and executed this day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty eight between John Middleton (as Trustee to and in Trust accounts by Henry Bittle to him for the benefit of Peter Edwards deceased) of the first part and Peter Edwards of the second part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia WMthpleth that whereas the said Middleton by virtue of and in strict pursuance of the above mentioned deed in Trust book doth hold the tract of land therein conveyed containing forty three acres as well the interest of the said Bittle in the lands of late George Bittle and sold the same for cash at public sale where the said Peter Edwards became the highest bidder at the price of two hundred and fifty dollars notwithstanding the said Middleton as Trustee aforesaid for and in consideration of the above circumstances aforesaid as well for and in the further consideration of the aforesaid sum of two hundred and fifty dollars to be in them paid or secured to be paid the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge hath given granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth give grant bargain sell make over and convey unto the said Peter Edwards the aforesaid tract of land ^{of land} by and being in the County of Southampton adjoining the lands of Oliver Bittle Francis Richards formerly by Bittle Maria Bittle Elisha Adkins Benj^l Hunt and the said Peter Edwards also all of his right and title interest claim and demand in and to the lands and plantation whereof his grand father Bittle did seize and possess of and now is the possessor of his grand father's Mother Lucy Bittle To Have and To Hold all the aforesaid land and premises with the appurtenances thereto belonging to him the said Peter Edwards his heirs &c the right and title of which I the said John Middleton as Trustee aforesaid doth hereby warrant and defend to him the said Peter Edwards against all persons claiming by through or under him as Trustee aforesaid said WMthpleth whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this day and year aforesaid

This Indenture made this 6th day of September in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and twenty eight between Benjamin L. Newsome of the first part Thomas B. Morrill of the second part and Peter Morrill of the third part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia WMthpleth that whereas the said Benjamin L. Newsome stands bound by a Court Compt Rend. for the sum of twenty one dollars and seventy five cents and costs executed Sept. 4th 1828 in favor of Feilding J. Mahone and the said Peter Morrill bound himself as security for the same to this Indenture WMthpleth that for and in consideration of the premises and also for the further consideration of the sum of one dollar to the said Benjamin L. Newsome on hand paid by the said Thomas B. Morrill. Trustee at or before the signing of delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Benjamin L. Newsome hath given granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth give grant bargain and sell alien or possess to the said Thomas B. Morrill his heirs and assigns forever the following property to wit one Quarter Bera and furniture one Trunk covered and a young team and bear one cupping table three heads of cattle and three increase for heads of sheep and three increase for heads of hogs and three increase and one bay horse To Have and To Hold unto him the said Thomas B. Morrill his heirs and assigns forever to and for the following intents uses and purposes that is to say provided the said Benjamin L. Newsome Newsome shall pay or cause to be paid the amount of the aforesaid Court Compt Rend and costs or before December
