Witnesseth that they said Alexander Fute adm^r as aforesaid in consideration of the sum of four hundred dollars lawful money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said John Rawlings have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain and sell unto the said John Rawlings his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land which the said John Rawlings purchased at public auction at the sale of land and Estate and known by the name of the Adams tract of land containing one hundred acres together with all and the appurtenances and easements and remainders appurtenant and other rents issues and other profits thereof and of every part and parcel thereof To have and to hold the said tract of land with the Tenements hereditaments and all and singular other the premises hereinbefore mentioned unto the said John Rawlings his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of him the said Alexander Fute adm^r or his assigns and of all and every person or persons whatsoever shall obtain no warrant and defend as adm^r by these presents In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this day and date above written
