This Indenture made and entered into on the 30th day of December in the year
 of our Lord Eighteen Hundred and twenty eight Between Samuel Vick and Tabitha his wife
 wife and John Barrett trustee to a certain deed in trust executed to them by said Samuel
 Vick for the benefit of Lewis Worrell, bearing date the 30th day of January 1827
 all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part, and Lewis
 Worrell of the same County and State of the other part. All which sheweth that
 Samuel Vick and Tabitha his wife for and in consideration of the sum of two
 hundred and twenty five dollars to them in hand paid by the said Lewis Worrell
 at or before the making and delivery of these presents, the receipt as being so truly
 acknowledged, have granted bargain and sold, and by these presents they each of them
 doth grant bargain and sell alien Enfranchise and conform unto them the said Lewis Worrell his
 heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of Land situate lying and being in the
 aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of St. Luke's containing by Metes and Bounds Eight
 and a half acres, to the same more or less it being the Lot n^o 5, drawn by said Samuel Vick
 in the division of the land of his father Jordan Vick dec^d and bounded as follows To wit Beginning
 at a Hickory corner for Lewis Vick in said Lewis Worrell's land thence along said
 line N 80. W 42. S poles to a Hickory corner thence at 89. E. 32.2 poles to a post set in a branch
 thence N 44. E 16 poles to a pine corner N 44. E 32.3 poles to a light wood post thence at 30
 E 58 poles to a corner of the land drawn by John Story and wife thence along his land S
 35. E 168 poles to a post, a corner in said Lewis Vick's line thence along his land S 47. W 114
 poles to the Beginning together with all right title interest claim or demand of law and to the
 aforesaid tract or parcel of Land and premises, with its appurtenances thence belonging or in
 any wise appertaining to him hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land
 and premises with all and singular its appurtenances thence belonging unto them the said
 Lewis Worrell his heirs and assigns forever, to and for the only proper use and behoof of
 of him the said Lewis Worrell, his heirs and assigns and the said Samuel Vick and Tabitha his
 wife for themselves their heirs Executors and assigns do and each of them doth hereby covenant
 and agree to and with the said Lewis Worrell, his heirs Executors and assigns that they will by their
 words and deeds and lawful aid and defense the right and title of the said tract or parcel of Land
 and premises, in every part or parcel thereof, against the claims or demands of all and every
 person or persons whatsoever and the said John Barrett Trustee as aforesaid for him-
 self his heirs or assigns or their doth hereby relinquish all the right and title of the aforesaid
 tract or parcel of Land which was vested in them by virtue of the aforesaid deed in trust
 Indenture whereof the said Samuel Vick and Tabitha his wife and John Barrett Trustee
 Trustee have been witnesses and appeared thence the day and date first within written
