This Indenture made and entered into on the 30th day of December under the
 form of Eighteen hundred and twenty eight Between Samuel Vick and Tabitha his
 wife and John Barrett trustee to a certain deed in trust executed to them by said Samuel
 Vick for the benefit of Lewis Worrell, bearing date the 30th day of January 1829
 all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part, and Lewis
 Worrell of the same County and State of the other part. Whereby it is shown that
 Samuel Vick and Tabitha his wife for and in consideration of the sum of two
 hundred and twenty five dollars to them in hand paid by the said Lewis Worrell
 at or before the making and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged, have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents they and each of them
 doth grant, bargain and sell alien Enfranchised and conform unto him the said Lewis Worrell his
 heirs and assigns forever, one certain tract or parcel of Land situate lying and being within
 the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of St. Luke's containing by Metes and Bounds Eight
 and a half acres, to be the same more or less it being the Lot of S. D. drawn by said Samuel Vick
 in the division of the land of his father Jordan Vick dec^d and bounded as follows To wit Beginning
 at a Hickory corner for Lewis Vick in said Lewis Worrell's line thence along said
 line N 80. W 45 S poles to a Hickory corner thence at 89 E. 23.2 poles to a post in a branch
 thence at 44 E 16 poles to a pine corner at 44 E 33.3 poles to a lightwood post thence at 30
 E 58 poles to a corner of the land drawn by John Story and wife thence along his line S
 35. E 168 poles to a post, a corner on said Lewis Vick's line thence along his line S 47 W 114
 poles to the Beginning together with all right title interest claim or demand of or in
 the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land and premises, with its appurtenances thence belonging or in
 any way appertaining To Have and to Hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land
 and premises with all and singular its appurtenances thence belonging unto him the said
 Lewis Worrell his heirs and assigns forever, to and for the only proper use and behoof of
 of him the said Lewis Worrell, his heirs and assigns and the said Samuel Vick and Tabitha his
 wife for themselves their heirs Executors and assigns do and each of them doth hereby covenant
 and agree to and with the said Lewis Worrell, his heirs Executors and assigns that they will by these
 presents warrant and forever defend the right and title of the said tract or parcel of Land
 and premises, and every part or parcel thereof, against the claims or demands of all and every
 person or persons whatsoever And the said John Barrett Trustee as aforesaid for him-
 self his heirs or representatives doth hereby relinquish all the right and title of the aforesaid
 tract or parcel of Land which was vested in him by virtue of the aforesaid deed in trust
