said Benjamin Griffin and Eley Joyner as Trustees aforesaid and by these presents give and grant unto the
said Benjamin Griffin and Eley Joyner as Trustees for the benefit of the Baptist Church at Black Rock
in the County aforesaid and their successors within the said Church or in any portion thereof or parts forever
One certain piece or parcel of land and privileges for the use of the said Church and no other as aforesaid
containing by a late survey four acres being the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit begin-
ning at a small red oak a corner of the poor house standing near the edge of a small branch between
S 80 W 113 poles to another small red oak a corner of said poor house land thence S 26 E 65° 1/2 pole to a
line a corner in James Jones line on the side of the road thence along said road S 50 E 13 poles to a
small red oak a corner in Charles Jones line thence S 26 W 50 pole to the first station together
with all and singular the houses out houses, outhouses buildings with all the privileges and appurtenan-
ces therunto belonging or in any way appertaining to the same or any part or parcel thereof for the only
proper use and service of the Church aforesaid as before expressed unto the said Benjamin Griffin
and Eley Joyner and their successors as aforesaid and the said Jonathan Parkford & Samuel
Turner for themselves their heirs and assigns doth by these presents covenant and grant to and with the
