son to give as Guardian to the Orphan Children of James Wright dec'd and I do
hereby bind myself to ratify the said signature so to be made by my said attorney
and to abide the consequences thereof in the same manner as if I had made the
same, with my own proper hand and seal at Richmon
the 16th day of January 1829

intermarriage with said James Chewter and I have never yet conveyed away the same
and likewise for a tract of thirty six acres acquired since my intermarriage with the
said James Chewter. Now These Indentures Witnesseth that I Mary Francis late
Mary Francis for and in consideration of the sum of three dollars to me
in hand paid at and before the sealing delivery hereof have and by these presents
do bargain sell alien relinquish and convey to the said Henry Moore all my
right title interest claim and demand right in to the aforesaid tract of thirty six acres
of Land owned by me before my intermarriage with my present husband James
Chewter to the said Moore his heirs Executors assigns for the purposes in the said
deed of Trust expressed and all my rights of demand in and to the tract of thirty six
acres acquired since our intermarriage I do hereby relinquish and convey to the said
Henry Moore for the purposes in the said deed of Trust expressed to his heirs Executors
Administrators or assigns In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and affixed my seal the 18th day of November in the year one thousand eight
hundred and twenty eight
