Summured To Governor 17th I now call men by these presents that Elias Summurell Thomas P Gray George B B Gray John Boykin James Pochelle William Pickens P A Wyckhart and John Nicholas Clements Rochelle are held and firmly bound unto William B Giles Esq Governor or Chief Magistrate of the Commonwealth of Virginia in the just and full sum of thirty thousand dollars to be paid to the said Governor and his successors for the use of the Commonwealth. For the payment whereof well and truly to be made we bind ourselves and each of us our heirs executors jointly and severally firmly by these presents sealed with our seals and dated this 19th day of January 1829

The Condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above named Elias Summurell is constituted and appointed Sheriff of the County of Southampton by a commission from the Governor under the seal of the Commonwealth dated the 20th day of December 1828 for one year from March Court next if therefore the said Elias Summurell shall truly and faithfully collect accounts for and pay the Taxes imposed by Law and all arrearages of Taxes due in the County of Southampton also truly and faithfully collect accounts for and pay the Militia fines due in the said County of Southampton for and all arrearages of Militia fines due in the said County and shall in all other things truly and faithfully execute the said Office of Sheriff during his Continuance therein then the above obligation to be void otherwise to remain in full force and virtue
