Know all men by these presents that Elias Summrell Thomas P Gray George B B Gray John Boykin James Pochelle William Pickens P A Wyghart and Gen. Nicholas Belmont are held and firmly bound unto William B Giles Esq Governor or Chief Magistrate of the Commonwealth of Virginia in the just and full sum of thirty thousand dollars to be paid to the said Governor and his successors for the use of the Commonwealth For the payment whereof well and truly to be made we bind ourselves and each of us our heirs executors administrators jointly and severally firmly by these presents sealed with our seals and date this 19th day of January 1829

The Condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above named Elias Summrell is constituted and appointed Sheriff of the County of Southampton by a commission from the Governor under the seal of the Commonwealth dated the 20th day of December 1828 for one year from March next & therefore the said Elias Summrell shall truly and faithfully collect accounts for and pay the Taxes imposed by Law and all arrears of Taxes due within the County of Southampton also truly and faithfully collect accounts for and pay the Militia fines due in the said County of Southampton for and all arrears of Militia fines due in the said County and shall in all other things truly and faithfully execute the said Office of Sheriff during his Continuance therein then the above obligation to be void otherwise to remain in full force and virtue

The Condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above named Elias Summrell is constituted and appointed Sheriff of the County of Southampton by a Commission from the Governor under the seal of the Commonwealth dated the 20th day of December 1828 for the Term of one year from March next & therefore the said Elias Summrell shall well and truly collect and receive all officers fees and dues put into his hands to collect and duly account for and pay the same to the officers to whom such fees and dues respectively at such times and places and limits by Law and shall well and truly execute and no one shall make of process and process to him arrested and pay and satisfy all sums of money and tobacco by him received by virtue of any such process to the person appearing
