The Indenture made this nineteenth day of January one thousand eight hundred and twenty nine
between Henry Kitchen of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part, James
Scott of the said County and State of the second part and Jonathan Scott of the County of South-
ampton and State of Virginia a son and of the said part. Whereas the said Henry
Kitchen stands justly indebted by note of hand to the said James Scott in the sum of forty
six dollars Current Money of the United States of America and whereas for the further
appearance of the payment of the same it is agreed by the parties hereto that a conveyance in Trust
shall be made unto the said Jonathan Scott for the benefit of the said James Scott of the sum
on the note aforesaid shall not be punctually paid with lawful interest thereon or on
before the first day of November next. Now this Indenture witnesseth that whereas Henry
Kitchen for and in consideration of the premises and for the sum of One dollar to him
in hand paid receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath bargained and sold and by
these presents doth for himself his heirs Executors and Administrators give grant bargain and
sell the said Jonathan Scott his heirs and assigns the following premises to him one manor house
on one acre and three poles with all the improvements thereto belonging to him one acre of land two fields
plots and garden one chest one table one iron pot and two sets of plates one chair one stool one
barrel of corn to have and to hold the aforesaid granted and bargained premises unto
the said Jonathan Scott his heirs and assigns in Trust forever and it is hereby declared
to be the true intent and meaning of these presents that of the said Henry Kitchen shall be
punctually paid to the said James Scott his heirs and assigns the sum of Forty six dollars
and interest agreeable to the sum of the said note to the said James Scott his heirs and assigns
Jonathan Scott his heirs and assigns shall hold the said goods and chattels above granted
to the said James Scott his heirs and assigns for the benefit of the said Henry Kitchen. And whereas Jonathan
Scott covenants and agrees with the parties hereto that if the said Henry Kitchen his
heirs Executors and assigns shall fail to make payment to the said James Scott his heirs and
assigns on or before the first day of November next the sum due on the note aforesaid
shall then be paid to the said Jonathan Scott his heirs and assigns shall be bound of the above
granted and bargained premises for the purpose following that is to say that at the
request of the said James Scott his heirs and assigns the said Jonathan Scott his heirs and
executors or either of them shall give ten days notice and sell as public
Sale the above mentioned property and shall pay the money therefrom to the said
James Scott his heirs and assigns after forth as shall be then due and after satisfying
of the said note of hand interest and all the expenses remaining or arising from the
notice and sale shall have the surplus money to the said Henry Kitchen or his
assigns to whom the same shall be delivered to receive and collect
