This Indenture made and entered into this 8th day of January in the year 1829
between Thomas Elefry of Southampton County 1st Carolina of the first part, Edward P.
Turner of Southampton County Virginia of the second part and ^{Benj^m} Turner of Guilford
County the third part. Witnesseth that whereas the said Benjamin Turner has been
sued in the County Court of Southampton as security for the said Thomas Elefry for a debt due
Levin Harris dec^d the debt and due supposed to amount to eighty dollars Reference being had
to the records well more especially to the said Benjamin Turner being obliged to suffer by
the same and the said Thomas Elefry being unwilling and desirous to save himself
the said Benj^m Turner from ^{such} engaging has this day granted bargain and sold and
by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Edward P. Turner for
the same and consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Edward
P. Turner the receipt whereof he hereby acknowledged all that the said Thomas Elefry
right title claim and interest in and to a certain negro man named Jacob now
occupied and owned by Permitt Jones in Dover right and be the said Thomas
Elefry doth for him self his heirs and assigns warrant and forever defend on behalf
the fee simple right of Jacob unto him the said E. P. Turner him and his heirs and
assigns against the claim of him the said Thomas Elefry and against the claim of all
persons claiming under him and all other persons whatever is upon Trust notwithstanding
that the said Edward P. Turner at any time subsequent to the first day of July next
being instructed by either the parties to this deed shall give ten days public notice of
the time and place of sale and proceed to sell the right hereby conveyed for cash and one
of the proceeds of the sale shall first pay to Benjamin Turner full amount of the
aforesaid debt including ^{cost} principal and interest then pay all reasonable expenses
and should a balance be then left pay the same to Thomas Elefry his order or
any person or authorities to receive it. All which for his honor and seals this day
