This Indenture made and entered into this 8<sup>th</sup> day of January in the year 1829  
 between Thomas Clifton of Southampton County State of Carolina of the first part Edward P.  
 Turner of Southampton County Virginia of the second part and Benj' Turner of Crimlapp  
 ton the third part. Witnesseth that whereas the said Benjamin Turner has been  
 sued in the County Court of Southampton as security for the said Thomas Clifton for a debt due  
 Leure Harris dec'd the cost and debts supposed to amount to Eighty Dollars Reference being had  
 to the records will more fully appear and the said Benjamin being willing to suffer by  
 the same and the said Thomas Clifton being willing and desirous to have himself  
 the said Benj' Turner from enjoining him this day granted his bond and sold and  
 by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Edward P. Turner for  
 the sum and consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Edward  
 P. Turner the receipt whereof he by a <sup>not</sup> acknowledged all this the said Thomas Clifton's  
 right title claim and interest in and to a certain negro man named Jacob now  
 occupied and owned by Dennis Jones in Wm's right and to the said Thomas  
 Clifton doth for himself his heirs and assigns warrant and forever defend on behalf  
 of the said simple right of Jacob unto him the said E. P. Turner him and his heirs and  
 assigns against the claim of the said Thomas Clifton and against the claim of all  
 persons claiming under him and all other persons whatsoever notwithstanding  
 that the said Edward P. Turner at any time subsequent to the first day of July next  
 being instructed by either the parties to this deed shall give ten days public notice of  
 the time and place of sale and proceed to sell the right <sup>thereby</sup> Conveyed for cash and out  
 of the proceeds of the sale shall first pay to Benjamin Turner <sup>the</sup> full amount of the  
 aforesaid debt including <sup>cost</sup> principal and interest when pay all reasonable expenses  
 and should a balance be then left pay the same to Thomas Clifton his order or  
 any person authorized to receive it. At witness our hands and seals this day

 thousand eight hundred and twenty nine between William Scholar Esq. of the first  
 part Garrison & Gleve of the second part and James M. Beale of the third part  
 all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia whereas the said William  
 Scholar Esq. is in debt to the said James M. Beale in the sum of forty  
 two dollars and by note and on demand this 13<sup>th</sup> January next unto him  
 with the legal interest thereon according the said William Scholar is willing and
