and to sell and deliver and all other transfers or assignments of the said land to the said John Grav and to hold the aforesaid three hundred acres of land herein before mentioned with the sum of two thousand dollars and twenty five cents and all the debts and damages and all other expenses herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold notwithstanding of their rights members and apprentices together with his aforesaid negro slave with the future increase of the females of them and all the other personal estate herein before mentioned unto him the said Ralph Graves his Executors administrators and Assigns for ever upon speculation only confidence nevertheless of the said James Jones his heirs Executors or Administrators shall make default and fail to the said Thomas Simpson administrator aforesaid then for aforesaid sum of one thousand three hundred and twenty eight dollars and eighty five cents add deducting therefrom the sum of Seven dollars and twenty Cents released as already mentioned with the interest and Costs that may be due thereon on or before the first day of December next but then and in that case the said Ralph Graves his Executors or Administrators may and shall and is hereby authorized and required upon the request of either party then have execution made upon or against having advertised the time and place of sale at least twenty days previous thereto at some public place to sell to the highest bidder for ready money the aforesaid three hundred acres of land and promised with the apprentices aforesaid and also the aforesaid negro slaves and other personal property herein mentioned and out of the proceeds of such sale in the first place to pay and satisfy the contingent expenses of such trust and then the debt one thousand seven hundred and twenty eight dollars and eighty five cents aforesaid deducting therefrom the sum of Seven dollars and twenty Cents aforesaid with the interest thereon from the fifth day of August one thousand eight hundred and twenty three till paid and anche Costs of said motion as aforesaid to the said Thomas Simpson and as aforesaid And the balance if any to pay over to the said James Jones his heirs Executors or Administrators onto such other person or persons as he the said James by writing under his hand shall appoint In W.D.M. whereof the parties to these presents have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day and year first above written Indented hereinafter signed sealed and delivered.
