This Indenture made this 2nd day of February eighteen hundred and twenty nine between Thomas W^o Gray of the County of Southampton of the first part and Willm C Jones of the same County of the second part witnesseth that the said Thomas W^o Gray for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred Dollars to him the said Thomas W^o Gray paid him or account before had granted by him and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Willm C Jones his heirs and assigns forever one tract or parcel of Land lying & being in the County of Southampton containing by estimation three hundred acres more or less lying on Rightwood & marsh and a young island of William West about three miles and Thomas and willm C Jones which formerly belonged to the said James Simpkins deceased who was guardian of Elizabeth A Goff by virtue of which said deed of Trust the said Ralph Graves exposed the aforesaid Land to public sale and the said Thomas W^o Gray became the purchaser thereof reference to the deed after said the same to be more fully appear & have and to hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land with all and singulars appurtenances therunto belonging unto him the said Willm C Jones his heirs and assigns forever and the said Thomas W^o Gray for himself his heirs executors and beneficiaries and defends unto the said Willm C Jones his heirs and assigns forever such title and such title only as is conveyed to him by the said Ralph Graves by the said Ralph Graves in Testimony whereof the said Thomas W^o Gray hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal this day of the first above written.

This Indenture made and entered into this 2nd day of February eighteen hundred and twenty nine between Willm C Jones of the County of Southampton of the first part J P Gray of the County of the second part and James Rochelle of the third part witnesseth that the said Willm C Jones hath and will give grant bargain and confirm unto the said James Rochelle certain tract or parcel of Land purchased by him of the said J P Gray by deed dated as above and recorded in the Clerks Office of Southampton together with all rights interest and demands of him the said Jones and his heirs forever upon trust nevertheless if the said Willm C Jones shall well and truly pay unto the said J P Gray the sum of Five hundred and eighty seven dollars for which sum the said Jones hath executed this bond unto the said Gray payable 25th of December eighteen hundred and thirty three this Indenture and every part hereof to be void but should the said Willm C Jones fail to pay to the said Thomas W^o Gray the aforesaid sum of money on or before the 25th of December next all interest and cost accruing thereon or attending the execution of these presents then it shall be lawful for the said James Rochelle his heirs or assigns at any time at the request of the said Thomas W^o Gray his heirs or assigns giving ten days notice of the time and place of sale whereof the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land to public sale for cash and out of the proceeds of such sale pay to the said Thomas W^o Gray the aforesaid sum of money with interest and costs as aforesaid and the surplus if any pay over to the said Willm C Jones his heirs executors and administrators in Testimony whereof the parties have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day & year first above written Willm C Jones
