of fifteen Dollars good and lawful money of Virginia to them in hand paid
by the said William Davis the receipt whereof the said John P Sadler and Sarah his
wife doth hereby acknowledge themselves fully and amply satisfied and paid shall
grant bargain sold alien dispose of and confirm and by these presents doth grant bargain
sell with the said William Davis his heirs assigns for ever one certain tract or
parcel of Land and premises situate lying and being in the County of Southampton
aforesaid Containing there about the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit
Beginning at a large pine the East side of the road thence Joseph I Wmble's line
East course to a corner pine between John P Sadler and Joseph I Wmble and John
Wright thence North to a red oak a corner for the said William Davis
thence West to the road or to a large red oak the South side of the road together
with the appurtenant structures belonging To have and to hold the said
Land and premises to him and his heirs forever and the said John P Sadler and
Sarah his wife for themselves their heirs &c doth by these presents covenant and agree
to and with the said William Davis his heirs and assigns that they their heirs
presentes warrant & forever defend all right title claim or demand of any person
