 granted bargained sold aliened bartered and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargained
 sold unto the said William Davis his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or
 parcel of Land and premises situate lying and being in the County of Southampton
 aforesaid containing there acres to the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit
 Beginning at a large pine tree East side of the road thence Joseph E. Wood in his line
 East course to a corner pine between John Gaddell and Joseph E. Wood and John
 Wryhart stumps both to a red oak a corner for the said William Davis
 same west to the road or to a large red oak the South side of the road together
 with the appurtenances therunto belonging To have and to hold the said
