Joseph Bradshaw formerly deceased containing twenty thousand a half acre to the same more or less  
and bounded as follows to wit by the lands of Arthur Brown, Jerry Joyner, Nathan Potts, John  
more Bradshaw, George Royal and Givina Bradshaw together with all the singular buildings houses  
barns building stables yards gardens or cleared lands lawns meadows pastures fruiting common  
woods underwood swamp water water course fishing her elegacments & immuniti advantages  
Emoluments her dittances and appurtenances whatsoever to the said Land belonging or appertaining  
or with the same used and enjoyed or accepted reported taken or known as part heretofore  
or as belonging to the same or may hereafter and the reversion and reversion of the same and
