at S 4. E 40 poles to a corner post oak in Daniel Scarborough's land S. 87. E 88 poles to a corner
sagworn in said Scarborough's line thence at East course along a line of markers
in said Scarborough's line thence along the said Scarborough's line an east course to
the corner of Morriston Ellis and Temperance Moore thence along a line of markers
thence in Benjamin Smith's line a south course to the white mulberry branch thence down
the said branch to a corner in Temperance Moore's line from thence a west course to
the beginning For and in the consideration of the sum of five hundred and thirty
seven dollar and 50^{cts} to Benjamin Smith do or come to be paid by the said Henry Moore
and the said Temperance Moore do warrant and for ever defend the right and
title of said bargained Land to be good to the said Henry Moore his heirs and assigns
for ever and against the claim or demand of any person or persons whatsoever

This Indenture made this 10th day of July one thousand eight hundred and twenty eight
between Henry Moore of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part
and John Wormack of said County and State of Virginia of the other part Witnesseth
that whereas the said Henry Moore being Trustee to a certain deed of Trust made and conveyed
to the said Henry Moore by James Newton do secure to John Wormack the payment of
of certain sum of money the said mentioned which Trust is duly recorded in the
Office in the Town of Jerusalem and specifies two certain tracts or parcels of Land
made and conveyed to the said Henry Moore as Trustee was ordered by John Wormack
one of the parties to advertise and make sale of the same and the said Henry did on this
day and date above written make sale of the above named tracts of Land to John Wormack
for the sum of two hundred dollar and the said Henry Moore as Trustee do sell
unto John Wormack two certain tracts or parcels of Land lying and being in the County
of Southampton and bounded as follows to wit beginning at a corner pine in Willie
Francis' line from thence to two persimmon trees near the ditch which is the dividing line
between the said lands and the land of the Westbrooks and thence along the said ditch to
a bay tree in a branch thence down the said branch to a sweet gum thence down to a water
oak on the sum of flat swamp thence down the sum of said Swamp to a sweet gum in
Willie Francis' line thence along the said Francis' line to a white oak the other tract
of Land is bounded as follows adjoining the land of Thomas James Edmund Kennedy
and others containing in both tracts sixty two acres be the same more or less beginning
in both tracts sixty two acres be the same more or less To have and to hold the said
tracts of Land with all and singular appurtenances and the said Henry Moore do
for himself his heirs and assigns do convey all the right and title that is now
