Prodnax in and to a certain tract or parcel of Land situate and being on the South side of round hill swamp in the County of Southampton formerly owned and occupied by Henry Adams during his life time and since his death by his heirs and devisees up to the 20th day of July in the year 1827 which said interest the said M^{rs} T.
