of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty nine between Peter D Beckman
of Rte 10 of the first part & Alexander P. Peete of the second part and Samuel Nicholson
of the third part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia
Witnessed to this
M^r Beckman by his son Peter D Beckman for and in consideration of the
sum of fifteen hundred dollars four hundred dollars due 25th December 1832
four hundred dollars due Decr 25th 1830 four hundred dollars 25th December
1831 and three hundred 25th December 25th 1832 which sum is due from
the said Peter D Beckman to the said S. P. Nicholson by Bond bearing date
the 3rd day of December one thousand eight hundred and twenty eight as well as
all other monies which may be due and owing from the said Peter D Beckman
to the said Samuel Nicholson by means of any dealing transfer of debt or paper
what ever as also for and in consideration of one dollar to be paid by
the said S. P. Nicholson to the receipt whereof the said Peter D Beckman doth fully
acknowledge hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth
hereby grant bargain and sell convey and make over unto the said A. P. Peete
and his heirs forever all his right and interest in the following property to wit
one tract of Land containing twenty five acres lying and being in the County of
Southampton County and known by the name of Parry's Dyke with all improve-
ments belonging to the said Peter D Beckman to have and to hold with all the
right and interest of the said tract of Land herein conveyed or intended to be
conveyed to him the said A. P. Peete his heirs and assigns forever upon this present
Indenture nevertheless that the said A. P. Peete upon being duly required by the said
Samuel Nicholson shall proceed to sell all the right and interest of the said
Peter D Beckman to the above named tract or parcel of Land hereby conveyed
or intended to be conveyed after advertising the same and place in the said
County of Southampton for ten days previous at some public house or shop
for cash amount of the money arising out of from the said sale in the said
place pay and satisfy all costs attending the said sale as well as his expenses
attending the said conveyance and then pay off the Bond aforesaid
with interest as well as all other monies which may appear to be due
and owing from the said Peter D Beckman to the said Samuel Nicholson by
means of any dealing transfer of debt or paper whatever as also the sum of five
pounds £5 and the right and title of the said tract of Land unto the
said A. P. Peete his heirs and assigns forever with liberty warrant and defend
against the lawful claim or claims of the said Peter D Beckman himself
from & from his and against all other every person or persons whomsoever
and the said Alexander P. Peete on his part concur and agrees that he
will make take of the right and interest hereby conveyed for the best
