This Indenture made this 12th day of February in the year of our
Lord 1829 between John Boyle of the first part and Stephen Murdough
of the second part and John Waddill of the third part and residents of North
Carolina the other parties residents of the state of Virginia and County of
Southampton whereas the said John Boyle is justly indebted to the said
John Waddill in the sum of twenty four hundred dollars and to be paid on
the 25th day of December in the year above written as by a Bond bearing date
on the 12th day of February in the year 1829 more fully appears at which
debt with the legal interest thereon accruing now This Indenture witness
eth that for and in consideration of the premises and also for the further considera-
tion of one dollar of lawful money of Virginia to the said John Boyle then
hand paid by the said Stephen Murdough at and before the sealing and
delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said
John Boyle then grant bargain and sold solemnly confessed released
confirmed and by these presents doth give grant bargain and release except
release and confirm to the said Stephen Murdough and his heirs and assigns
for ever the following slaves four horses waggon and harness and one
cotton gin the names of the negroes are as follows Lysphas Kate Miles
Aaron Boy Jim man Jim Chaney Boy Mader and Martha Childen
Mannah Charles Heans Aaron and the future increase of the females
of the females of the said slaves To have and to hold the aforesaid slaves
and the future increase of the females thereof together with the four horses
one waggon and harness & one cotton gin unto the said Stephen Murdough
his heirs Executors and assigns forever and the said John Boyle for himself
his heirs Executors and assigns forever doth hereby covenant promise and
agree to and with the said Stephen Murdough his heirs Executors and
assigns forever in manner and form following that is to say that the said
John Boyle his heirs Executors and assigns the aforesaid slaves and the future
increase of the females thereof unto the said Stephen Murdough his heirs
Executors and assigns againest all persons whatsoever together with four
horses one waggon and harness and one cotton gin shall and will warrant
forever defend by these presents when times may require that the said Stephen Mur-
dough his heirs Executors and assigns shall permit the said John Boyle to remove
in quiet and peaceable possession of the aforesaid slaves horses waggon
harness and cotton gin and take the profits thereof to his own use
until default be made in the payment of the said sum of twenty four hundred
dollars when in the whole or in part and then when the said John Boyle
shall owe will do soon after the happening of such default of any sum
