This Indenture made the 16th day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty nine between Mills & Lawrence of the County of Isle of Wight of the one part William Lawrence of the County of Southampton of the other part Witnesseth that the said Mills & Lawrence in consideration of three hundred and eleven pounds of money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said William Lawrence at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said William Lawrence ^{being} in the County of Southampton and born dead as follows Beginning at Black Water Bridge thence down said Black Water to the place called honey hole by which there is a small ford and aft.
