This Indenture made the 11<sup>th</sup> day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and twenty nine & between Mills Lawrence of the County of Isle of Wight of the one part William Lawrence of the County of Southampton of the other part WITNESSETH that the said Mills E Lawrence in Consideration of five hundred dollars Lawful money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said William Lawrence at or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents doth convey and sell unto the said William Lawrence lying in the County of Southampton and bounded as follows Beginning at Black Water Bridge thence down said black water to the place called punch hole by which it bears a small fork and after so far as Thomas White's thence along the said White's line to a Hickory corner for the said White's and Jonathan Carter thence the said Carter's line to the head thereof the main road to Black Water Bridge the Beginning being situated Three hundred acres to the Beginning containing three hundred acres with all the advantages emoluments hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever the said Land belonging or appertaining or with the same used or enjoyed and the reversion and reversions remainder and remainders to have and to hold the said with the tenements hereditaments and lands singular other the premises before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold unto the said William Lawrence his heirs and assigns forever and the said Mills E Lawrence for himself his heirs and assigns the said Land with all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said William Lawrence his heirs and assigns for from the claim or claims of him the said Mills E Lawrence of him in either his heirs and of all and every person or person or persons whatsoever shall be and do warrant and forever defend these presents In Writing whereof the said Mills E Lawrence have hereunto set his hand and seal this day and year first above written
