Commissioners have granted bargained and sold and by this presents do grant bargain
and sell unto the said Joseph Brown his husband and wife for ever one certain
tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton containing
four hundred and eighty seven 1/2 acres more or less and bounded as follow
to Mr. D. Quinnings a corner white oak on the Raccoon Swamp thence S. W. 1/2
poles to a branch the County line thence up said branch to a sycamore S. 39 1/2 E. 18 6 poles
to sycamore S. 3 1/2 E. 14 8 poles to a corner sycamore in the field thence N. 88 1/2 E. 12 6 poles
to Willoway River thence down said River 28 poles to a corner Hickory or Chestnut
side of said River thence N. 61 E. 30 poles N. 47 1/2 E. 31 poles to a corner Hickory on
the west side of the Riedy Branch thence down the various courses of the said
Branch to Willoway River thence up said River 28 poles to a white oak on the
