Reed neglect or fail to pay the aforesaid several Bonds wherein they common demand with the interest thereon so that the said Nathaniel Francis may have to pay or be likely to pay or from any other cause think himself in danger of suffering by reason of the security ship aforesaid that then in that event it shall be lawful and declared to be the true intent and meaning of these presents for him the said Austin Middleton at the request of either party himself or their representative to sell the aforesaid tract of Land on such premises for and attorneying at least twenty days public notice of the time and place of sale, let out of the proceeds of said sale he the said Austin Middleton is first to pay all sums of money which the said Nathaniel Francis hath or may be likely to pay as security aforesaid by all incurred by the execution of these presents and the balance pay over to the said John W. Reed or his legal representative and in case the aforesaid several Bonds be fully paid and no charge so that the said Nathaniel Francis shall be wholly acquitted and exonerated from the security ship aforesaid trust by the said A. Middleton at the request of the said Nathaniel Francis or his representative when make release and give a quitclaim of the property conveyed. This Indenture made and executed this 17<sup>th</sup> day of February in the year of our Lord  
One thousand Eight hundred and twenty nine and between Edward Pittillo of the first part  
Middleton John W. Reed of the second part and Austin Middleton who is mutually chosen as  
one two of the third part all of the County of Southampton and state of Virginia.

Witnesseth that whereas the said John W. Reed stands bound as security for  
the said Edward Pittillo in a bond executed the 13<sup>th</sup> day of February 1829 in the sum  
of Five hundred dollars and the said Edward Pittillo being willing and desirous  
to secure and have from the said John W. Reed from the payment of the sum  
or any part thereof as well from all trouble damage or other inconvenience which  
he might sustain by reason of the security ship aforesaid hath agreed to convey  
and do hereby convey to the said Middleton as trustee aforesaid the following  
Negro slaves To wit Jacob Jeffrestaney and Mary. Now therefore the said Edward  
Middleton further witnesseth that the said Edward Pittillo for and in consideration  
of the circumstances aforesaid as will appear in the further consideration of the  
sum of One dollar to him the said Edward Pittillo in hand paid by the said  
Austin Middleton as trustee the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said  
Edward Pittillo hath bargained and sold and conveyed and by these presents do give grant  
bargain make over and convey unto the said Middleton as trustee aforesaid the aforesaid  
negro slaves To wit Jacob Jeffrestaney and Mary together with their children  
increased upon trust and upon this express condition that should the said
