

John W. Reese or his representative have any of the said money to pay for
 on one himself in danger of suffering by reason of the security which is given
 that then and in that case it shall be lawful and declared to be the true
 intent and meaning of these presents for the said Middleton or his representa-
 tive to sell for cash the aforesaid negro slaves in the town of New Orleans
 after giving at least ten days notice of the time and place of sale and out
 of the proceeds of sale first pay and satisfy all sums of money
 which the said John W. Reese shall have paid as well as that which he may
 be most likely to pay by way in consequence of the security which aforesaid
 and the balance pay over to the said Drury & Bille or his representative
 But should the said Drury & Bille pay and discharge the said Bond
 so that the said John W. Reese shall be wholly released and discharged
 that then and in that case it shall be lawful for the said Middleton
 as Trustee aforesaid at the request of the said John W. Reese or his
 representative to make release give acquittances and release of the said
 negro slaves and it is understood by the parties that the said Drury
 & Bille shall remain in peaceable and quiet possession of the said negro
 slaves until they shall be demanded by the said Middleton or his representa-

 March 15/1830 and Polly his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Forty Dollars given
 unto which said sum is due to the said John Wyckham from the Benjamin
 Westra by Bond bearing date the 20th day of October in the year one thousand
 Eight hundred and twenty Eight as well as all other monies to which may be due
 and owing from the said Benjamin Westra to the said John Wyckham
 by means of any dealings Transfer of debts or paper whatever as also for and in
 consideration of one dollar to me in hand paid by the said James B. Wyckham
 the receipt whereof the said Benjamin Westra and Polly his wife do hereby
 acknowledge have granted bargained sold and by these presents do hereby
 grant bargain and sell convey make over unto the said James B. Wyckham
 and his heirs for ever all his right and interest in the following property to wit
 Two Slaves viz. a chain & all the bal. of my household & furniture of every
 description also the crop of corn and cotton stock of hogs cattle and sheep
 with all my plantation utensils and a cart and gear and one horse
 Also two portions of a tract of Land owned formerly by Nancy Worme
 viz. Polly Worme's portion of eleven and a half acres & thirteen and
