Persons Harris One part and Lewis Harris of the aforesaid County and State of New York the other part Whereas it is agreed between George Gray of the County of Southampton and State of New York of the one part and Lewis Harris of the aforesaid County and State of the other part That the said George Gray in order to secure the payment of the following debt (\$25) or written obligation under the hand of the said George Gray executed to the said Harris the 23rd day of the present month January aforesaid for the sum of Two Thousand & Seventy seven dollars on demand he the said George Gray doth grant bargains and sell unto the said Lewis Harris the following negro boy named Nelson and Isham To have and to hold the said bargained and sold negroes unto him the said Lewis Harris his heirs & assigns for ever upon Trust nevertheless and upon this express condition that of the said George Gray shall fail to make true and faithful payment of the debt above mentioned with interest thereon from before the date above when in that case the said Lewis Harris as Trustee to this Indenture at the request of the said Joel Harris shall after having demanded the same and place of sale after ten days previous thereto proceed to sell the negroes herein before mentioned to the highest bidder for ready money and out of the monies arising from the sale in the first place pay and satisfy all reasonable expenses attending such sale and then the debt above mentioned and the residue of monies if any arising from such sale as aforesaid to the use of the said George Gray his executors and assigns or to such person or persons he by writing under his hand shall appoint and in default of such appointment to such person or persons as would be then entitled by statute for distribution of intestates Estates In witness whereof the parties to this Indenture have set their hands and seals this day and year above written
