This Indenture made this fourteenth day of March one thousand eight hundred and twenty nine between Elijah Soyner of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Elisha Soyner of the County and State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said Elisha Soyner for and in consideration of the sum and full term of Five hundred dollars current money of the United States of America in hand paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged and the said Elijah Soyner hath given granted bargained and sold with legal presents doth give grant bargain and sell unto the said Elisha Soyner and his heirs and assigns forever all his right title interest and claim of and in the tract or parcel of Land and the appurtenances thereto belonging in the County of Southampton which the said Elijah Soyner and Elisha Soyner bought of Samuel Soyner and his wife solely by their deed of bargain and sell bearing date the eighteenth day of November one thousand eight hundred and twenty two and is of record in the Clerk's Office for the County Court of Southampton aforesaid containing by estimation one hundred and fifty acres be the same more or less bounded by the known and reputed bounds thereof To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land with all and every the appurtenances unto the said Elisha Soyner his heirs and assigns To the only proper use and behoof of the said Elisha Soyner his heirs and assigns forever and the said Elijah Soyner his heirs and assigns and administrators the said tract or parcel of Land with the appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said Elisha Soyner his heirs and assigns shall and will warrant and forever defend by their presents Witnesseth that the said Elijah Soyner hath therunto set his hand and seal the day and year first above written

Rochelle of the same County and State of the other part Witnesseth that the said Nathaniel Rochelle and Francis his wife for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred and dollars to them in hand paid by the said William B. Rochelle the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said Nathaniel Rochelle and Francis his wife have bargained granted and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said William B. Rochelle his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of Land situate lying and being in the County above written containing and bounded and twenty acres more or less and known by the name of Parkman's and Culchin's Tracts and bounded as follows on East by the lands of Thomas Wren on the South by the lands formerly owned by Williamson Capell on the West by the lands of William B. Rochelle and on the North by Lands of Lucy Harwood and one Harry Chant. It being all the lands devised to him by Levi Rochelle dec'd To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land with all the appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said William B. Rochelle to be held by him and his heirs forever and the said Nathaniel Rochelle and Francis his
