This Indenture made this 30th day of December the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty eight Between Richard Hill and Elizabeth his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and John Barnett of the same County and State of the other part Witness that the said Richard Hill and Elizabeth his wife for and in consideration of the sum of five dollars to them in hand paid by the said John Barnett at or before the entering in and delivery of the presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said John Barnett his heirs and assigns forever all our right title interest and claim in and to a certain tract or parcel of Land lying in the aforesaid County of Southampton of the County of Southampton to wit part of the land formerly belonging to Nelson Hill deceased which was assigned to the said John Hill for his share of the same and he is to report as well that the said John Hill has caused to hold the said tract or parcel of Land and premises with its appurtenances thenceforth belonging unto him the said John Barnett and his heirs forever and the said Richard Hill and Elizabeth his wife do for themselves their heirs executors administrators and assigns forever warrant and defend the lawful claim or claims of the said tract or parcel of Land or any part thereof against all and every person or persons whatsoever In W^m M^{rs} whereof the said Richard Hill and Elizabeth his wife have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day & date first above written
