This Indenture made this 10th day of March 1829 between Geo H Gentry of the County of
Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part and Jeremiah Cobb of the County and State aforesaid
said of the second part and Henry Briggs of the County and State aforesaid of the third part Witnesseth
that whereas the said Geo H Gray is jointly indebted to the said Henry Briggs in the sum of
two hundred and sixty four dollars and 00^{cs} as by a bond bearing date with these
presents will more fully appear which said debt with legal interest thereon according
the said Geo H Gray is willing and desirous to secure from the Indenture aforesaid
that for and in consideration of the premises and also for the further consideration of
the sum of one dollar of lawful money of Virginia to the said Geo H Gentry then paid
by the said Jeremiah Cobb at or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged he the said Geo H Gray has given granted bargained and
sold and by these presents does give grant bargain and sell to the said Jeremiah Cobb
his heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the
County of Southampton and State of Virginia containing fifty three acres & a quarter more
or less the same more or less and bounded as follows To wit Beginning at a dogwood in
West Wells line thence S 60th W 22 poles to a post oak S 68th W 11th to a post S 21th W 11th
to a pine S 31th W 16th 3 poles to a gum a corner of Richard Commons Land thence S
26th N 12th 5 p. to a corner in the road thence S 80th E 87th 3 p. To two dogwood a corner
thence S 38th E 91th to the Beginning with all and singular appurtenances to the
said tract or parcel of Land belonging or in any wise appertaining To Have and to
hold the said hereby granted parcel or tract and premises with the appurtenances
unto the said Jeremiah Cobb his heirs forever to the only proper use
and behoof of the said Jeremiah Cobb his heirs forever And the said Geo H Gray
for himself his heirs & doth hereby covenant and agree to and with the said Jeremiah
Cobb his heirs & forever in manner and form following That to say that the said
Geo H Gray his heirs & the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land and premises with
their appurtenances unto the said Jeremiah Cobb his heirs & against all persons
whomsoever shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents when first
nevertheless that that the said Jeremiah Cobb his heirs & shall permit the said
Geo H Gray to remain in quiet and peaceable possession of said tract or parcel of Land
& premises with its appurtenances and take the profits thereof to his own use and until
default he made in the payment of the said sum of \$264. 70^{cs} within the whole
or in part and then upon the first default of such default of payment he
his heirs & shall and will be soon after the happening of such default of payment he
the said Jeremiah Cobb his heirs & may think proper or the said Henry Briggs
his executor admors or assigns shall request all the said tract of Land
and premises with the appurtenances or such part of the tract granted premises
as the said Jeremiah Cobb his representatives hereby authorized to act shall think

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
