This Indenture made this 31st day of February in the year of our Lord
1829 between Thomas Harrison of the first part William L Evers of the second
part and John A Persons of the third part all of the County of Northampton
State of Virginia Witnesses whereas the said Thomas Harrison being party
indebted to the said John A Persons in the sum of two hundred and thirty dollars
and forty one cents due by note bearing equal date with these presents and on demand
one day after date and whereas the said John A Persons stands bound for the said
Thomas Harrison as his security in the following debts to wit a note executed to
Benj^l & E^l Turner & Co for three hundred and seven dollars and seventy five cents
on demand the 31st of August 1825 or thereabouts a note executed to John W
Mason for fifty three dollars and seventy five cents reference may be had to
the said note to ascertain the date and interest A note executed to John
Fann for one hundred and forty two on demand the 30th of October or thereabouts
and for the cost of a suit in the Chancery Court of Northampton Term of 1826
of 1826 who was against Henry Harris dec^d defendant and Benjamin Harris
the plaintiff in a forth coming and delinquent Bond for the sum of fifty seven dollars
paid to the Sheriff of Brunswick County for the benefit of John Evers
