Harrison To Everett Tins Delverne John A Person 16 March 1830 -

This Indenture made this 31st day of February in the year of our Lord
1829 Between Thomas Harrison of the first part William E. Fenn of the second
part and John A. Persons of the third part all of the County of Southampton
State of Virginia Attestable whereas the said Thomas Harrison being party
and the other to the said John A. Persons in the sum of two hundred and thirty dollars
and forty one cents due, by note bearing equal date with these presents and on demand
one day after date and whereupon the said John A. Persons stands bound for the said
Thomas Harrison as his security in the following debts to wit a note executed to
Henry J. Peckman Esq for three hundred and seven dollars and twenty five cents
in termes the 31st of August 1828 or thereabouts a note executed to John W.
Mason for fifty three dollars and twenty five cents reference may be had to
the said note to ascertain the date and interest A note executed to John
Gunn for one hundred and forty two on demand the 20th of October or thereafter
and for the cost of a suit in the Circuit Court of Southampton Town a/cnt of Jep
D. Proff who was a/cnt of Henry Harris and 3 defendant and Benjamin Gunn
the plaintiff in a forth coming and delivering bond for the sum of fifty two dollars
and 1/4 to the Sheriff of Brunswick County for the benefit of Peter Edwards
a/cnt of Barbara Edwards and a note executed to Amos Stanis for forty two
dollars and thirty seven cents dated the 20th February 1829 All of which
debts reference being paid to the notes will more fully appear And further
Thomas Harrison being desirous and willing to become the aforesaid debtors to him
the said John A. Persons and also his heirs and to receive from the said John A.
Persons from paying or being in any way injured by the aforesaid security debt
have for and in consideration of the premises and the further consideration of
one dollar to him the said Thomas Harrison in hand paid by the aforesaid
William E. Fenn the receipt whereof he hereby acknowledges Given
granted long since sold released and confirmed and by these presents doth
give grant bargain sell release and confirm unto the said William
