 do grant bargain sell convey and confirm unto the said Mrs A Morris her
 heirs and assigns all the right title claim and interest which the said Evers
 Harris now do^o had of in and to the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land in
 the said decree mentioned and ordered so to be sold by the said Evers Harris
 Commissioner by his and being in the County and State aforesaid and on the
 North Side of Meherrin River containing four hundred and fifty six acres
 be the same more or less and bounded as follows (to wit) By the land of said
