Deed) This Indenture made and entered into this 19<sup>th</sup> day of March in the year of our Lord  
One thousand Eight hundred and twenty nine between Jefr<sup>e</sup> Drury of Southampton  
Sharpe Town of the one part Thomas J<sup>t</sup> Harper of the town of Easton Edmunds the other part  
all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia witnesseth that whereas the said  
Jefr<sup>e</sup> Drury is justly indebted to the said Carter Edmunds in the sum of Three Thousand  
and thirty dollars and \$100 due by obligation bearing date the 19<sup>th</sup> day of March  
1829 which debt with the legal interest thereon accruing the said Jefr<sup>e</sup> Drury  
willing and desirous to secure now therefore this Indenture made and entered into  
this day and year aforesaid witnesseth that the said Jefr<sup>e</sup> Drury for and in con-  
sideration of the premises as well for the further consideration of one dollar to him  
in hand paid at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt  
whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Jefr<sup>e</sup> Drury shall grant a long and  
good almon and convey to and by these presents debt granted by him all almon and  
royalty unto the said Thomas J<sup>t</sup> Harper his heirs and assigns forever the following particularized  
personal Estate to wit all the real Estate of which the said Drury is seized in Southampton  
County containing by estimation four hundred and thirty seven acres together with the  
appurtenances thereto belonging and the following slaves to wit Ann Willis & her child  
Henry & her children Elizabeth and Mary a boy and his child and Eliza & Matthew and  
the future increase of the females and the following other property to wit To have and  
to hold the said real and personal Estate with all the appurtenances therunto belonging  
to the said Thomas J<sup>t</sup> Harper the Trustee his heirs Executors & assigns forever free  
from the claim or claims of him the said Drury his heirs Executors & assigns In Trust manner  
hereby it is the said Thomas J<sup>t</sup> Harper shall permit the said Jefr<sup>e</sup> Drury to remain  
in quiet and peaceable possession of the said real and personal Estate and take the  
profits to his own use until default be made in the payment of the aforesaid debt  
due as aforesaid to the said Carter Edmunds and then upon this further Trust & Condition  
that the said Thomas J<sup>t</sup> Harper the Trustee shall soon after the default make the  
payment of the said sum of money either in whole or in part as the said Carter  
Edmunds or his Executor or administrators & assigns shall require having given at least  
forty days previous notice of the time and place of sale at his own direction  
sell the said Estate or such part thereof as may be necessary to satisfy and pay  
the debt interest and expenses attending and out of the money arising from such  
sale shall first pay the expenses of the sale and then satisfy and pay to the said  
Carter Edmunds his heirs Executors & assigns the debt aforesaid together with  
the interest which may thence lawfully have accrued And the said Jefr<sup>e</sup> Drury  
doth warrant and defend the title to the said real and personal Estate to the said  
Trustee his heirs & assigns free from the claim of all and every person or persons and the  
said Trustee doth furthermore covenant and agree that any balance which shall  
remain in his hands after satisfying the claim of the said Edmunds and expenses  
of the sale of the same shall be paid over to the said Jefr<sup>e</sup> Drury his heirs Executors  
Administrators or assigns But if the said Jefr<sup>e</sup> Drury shall satisfy and pay the debt  
and interest aforesaid so that no default be made in the payment of the said debt  
and interest then this Indenture to be void else to remain in full force & virtue
