sum of seventy five dollars 75^{cs} by bond bearing date the 6th day March 1829
with interest thereon due paid which the said Marcha Bradshaw is willing and
desires to secure Now this Indenture Witnesseth that for and in considera-
tion of the premises and also for the further sum of \$ One dollar of lawful
money of Virginia to the said Marcha Bradshaw in hand paid by the said James
Counsel at or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof
he hereby acknowledges she the said Marcha Bradshaw hath given granted bargained
and sold released and confirmed and by these presents do give grant bargain and
confer unto the said James Counsel his heirs and assigns forever the following property
One negro man named Jim W. It appears old belonging to the said Marcha Bradshaw
with all the interest right title claim or demand of the above mentioned property To have
and to hold the said hereby granted or intended to be granted property negro Tom
hereby unto the said James Counsel his heirs executors and assigns forever and the said
Marcha Bradshaw for herself her heirs executors and assigns do hereby promise
promise and agree and with the said James Counsel his heirs &c in manner and form
following that is to say that the said Marcha Bradshaw her heirs executors &c
the aforesaid mentioned negro Tom unto the said James Counsel his heirs executors
assigns against all persons whatsoever that and will warrant & defend against for the
