Witnesseth that the said Elias Summurell Commissioner as aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred dollars to him in hand paid or seems to be paid by the said George Branch & at and before the entering and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged & has bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain and sell unto the said George Branch & his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton containing by Estimation one hundred twenty nine and one half acres be the same more or less and bounded by the land of the said George Branch, William Plancek and others. Having Valentine Branch's proportion of all the land belonging to the Estate of his father. Awdromo Branch deceased with all and singular the appurtenances whatsoever therein belonging or in any way appertaining and the reversion and reversions Remainders and Remainders partly and other rents issues and profits and every part and parcel thereof To Have and to hold the said land with the tenements hereunto in and attached and singular other the premises herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold every part and parcel thereof with every of them Right Minors and appurtenances unto the said George Branch & his heirs and assigns forever and the said Elias Summurell Commissioner as aforesaid for himself from thenceforth the said Land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said George Branch & his heirs and assigns free from all claim or claim of him the said Elias Summurell Commissioner as aforesaid and his heirs and of all and every person or persons whatsoever claiming from or through him as Commissioner will warrant and defend forever unto the said George Branch & all his heirs and title to the above mentioned land as Commissioner and no other by these presents In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the day & year above written signed sealed published and declared

Witnesseth that the said William Elliott for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred and thirty three dollars and thirty three and one third Cents in hand paid unto my Father Ephraim Elliott by the said Carr Pardew before the entering and delivery of these presents the receipt and payment of the said William Elliott doth hereby acknowledge and therein it being fully entered his consented and paid back granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien Enfeoff and confirm unto him the said Carr Pardew his heirs and assigns one certain Lot or piece of Land containing by a late survey twenty five acres by more or less and being in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia and bounded by William Starusent and the said Carr Pardew Having the Lot of Land assigned to my mother Peggy Elliott in the division of the lands of her Father William Starusent as will more fully appear by reference to the Commissioners Report filed in the Solers Office of said County
