This Indenture made this 3rd day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty eight Between Miley Doles and Sally his wife of the one part and Eliza Johnson of the other part all of the County of Southampton parish of Nottomay and Hamlet of Brigemas Wm Meppell that he and Miley Doles and wife Sally in consideration of the sum of Nine dollars lawful money of Brigemas to him in hand paid by the said Eliza Johnson at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents doth receipt returne & hereby acknowledge to have bargained and sold and by these presents doth and each of them bargain and sell unto the said Eliza Johnson his heirs and assigns one certain tract or parcel of Land lying in the County and Parish aforesaid containing by estimation four acres to the sume more or less being a part of the land the said Dolestowth of David Eastapham and knowne by Benj. Griffin and others to have and to hold the said four acres of Land which is unprovided the said Eliza Johnson To have and to hold the said land to her and her heirs forever to and for the only proper use and behoef of her the Eliza Johnson his heirs and assigns forever and the said Miley Doles and Sally his wife for themselves and their heirs with all and singular the premises hereunto mentioned unto the Eliza Johnson his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of them the said Doles and Sally his wife and of all and every other person or persons wherun shall and wills warrant and forever defend by these presents In witness whereof the said Miley Doles and Sally his wife herunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day and year first above written
