the County of Southampton of the first part. & Thomas of the County of Isle of Wight  
of the second part. Messrs Boyd & Phelps. Booksellers Stationers Printers  
Daugherty & Robertson all merchants of the city of New York. Esqrs Bankers  
of Southampton County of the third part. Witnesseth that the said Geo E Holmes  
being indebted to the said parties of the third part in divers summs of money which  
may be ascertained exactly by reference to their several obligations or claims  
therefore as also in consideration of one dollar in hand paid by the said William  
Holmes to the said George E Holmes as to before the installing or delivery of the  
presente the receipt whereof is by the said George E Holmes hereby acknowledged  
by the said Geo E Holmes which given grantis long and well alredy expoffed  
affirms and make over and by these presents doth give grantis in all respects  
aforesaid and make over unto County all his right title and interest in and to the  
Tennement contracted for with Robert Govorn of the County of Southampton  
together with the house thereon lately raised in Jerusalem on the lot of land  
of Robert Govorn with the appurtenances & privileges therunto belonging to wch  
wch aforesaid as also the utensils and other materials already provided or contracted  
for necessary to the furnishing and completion thereof also all the good wares  
merchandise of all and every kind and description now in his store consisting  
of dry goods hardware cutlery crockery & groceries also all his bonds notes bills accounts  
due from all and every person to him the said George E Holmes in any sume due and owing  
To have and to hold the said conyng property or liberty intended to be conveyed to him  
the said William Holmes his heirs and assigns forever reserving the cincnt and  
confirmed nevertheless that in as much as the said William Holmes holds  
aforesaid debt to said George E Holmes as well as the above named persons  
enumerated above that he the said William Holmes shall discharge the property  
thence presente conyng or intended to be conveyed in such manner as he shall deem  
most eligible and advisable to secure the true and faithful payment of the said  
of the said persons respectively and after paying and satisfying the said specified  
debt that he shall pay the debt due from the said George E Holmes to Mr Nathan  
Mason for which Samuel Holmes and Mrs A Brown of Southampton County  
are sureties and that should any surplus remain that he shall have to leave to the  
of Jerusalem the debt due to him In witness whereof the said George E Holmes has  
signed set to his hand and affixed his seal the day and year first above written
