 Four hundred and fifty two dollars to him in hand paid by the said James Harrison
 at or before the sealing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell
 to the said James Harrison his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel
 of Land containing ninety one acres lying and being in the County of Southampton
 the North side of Herbert Branch situated and bounded as follows To wit Beginning
 at a pine a man made corner on Benjamin E. Horton's line thence along his line
 N 66° 32' E 26 pole to a red oak N 67° E 15 3/4 poles to a pine N 22° W 5 1/4 poles to a
 Maple N 15° E 3 poles to a red oak a corner to William A. Stone's thence along his line
 N 29° E 77 poles to Herbert Branch up said Branch as it means and to a Maple
 corner to said George Ivey thence along his line S 17° 30' N 12 pole to a pine N 10° W 11
 1/2 poles S 51° N 12 poles S 51° N 36 pole to a pine and N 18° W 92 pole to the Beginning The
 right and title of said Land we do warrant and forever defend to him his heirs
 assigns forever To have and to hold the said Land and premises with the
