 This Indenture made and entered into this 19th day March one thousand Eight
 hundred and twenty seven by and between Richard B. Day of the first part Nathaniel Rochee
 of the second part and Jonathan T. Griffen of the third and last part each all the above
 named parties being of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia whereas the said
 Delivered to said (Richard B. Day) is indebted to the said Jonathan T. Griffen in the sum of Thirty dollars
 appearing by bond as well as this Indenture and the said Richard B. Day being well enough
 1829 desirous to secure the payment of the aforesaid debt together with interest which there
 hereafter accrue thereon nor therefore the said Richard B. Day having consens
 tion thereof and for the further consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand
 paid by Nathaniel Rochee at and before entering and delivering hereof the record
 of which is hereby acknowledged and from every part of which the said Nathaniel Rochee
 and all his legal representatives are forever released exonerated and discharged
 he the said Richard B. Day have bargained and sold and do by these presents give and
 sell unto the said Nathaniel Rochee his heirs and assigns one black horse two ponies
 Ex^d 1 Bed and furniture six sitting chairs one walnut table one pine table and my part of the
 Crop of Cotton and Corn that I shall make this year To Have and to hold the above
 named property and every part thereof unto him the said Nathaniel Rochee his heirs
 and assigns forever and all the right title interest and Estate of in and to the above
 described property but this conveyance in Trust nevertheless and if the said Rich
 B. Day or any other person or persons on his behalf shall pay the debt for which the
 Conveyance was made at or before the time that the payment of this debt
 shall be required that in such case this Indenture shall be void and of no effect
 but in such case the payment of the said debt shall not be made at or before the time
 being demanded by the said Jonathan T. Griffen or some other person rightly entitled
 to make such demand then it shall be lawful and the bounden duty of the said Nathaniel
 Rochee his Executor or administrator to make sale of the above described property for the
 first giving ten days previous public notice of the time and place of such sale by advertise
 ments posted up in three or more public places in the aforesaid County of Southampton
 and of the proceeds of such sale pay the cost hereby incurred and then the debt aforesaid
 together with the interest which shall have accrued and of surplus money shall
 remain the same shall be paid over to the said Richard B. Day or to his or some one of
 the said Richard B. Day doth hereby warrant and defend the title of the above
 named property unto him the said Nathaniel Rochee his heirs and assigns forever
