This Indenture made and entered into on the 13th day of March in the year of our Lord's Septim
hundred and twenty nine. Between John Tick of Jordan, of the first part John Barrett Trustee of the
Barrett Trust second part, and Lewis Worrell of the third part all of the County of Touchampton and State of Virginia
Witnesseth that whereas the said John Tick stands jointly indebted unto the said Lewis Worrell
by bond bearing even date with these presents for the sum of five hundred and seventy seven dollars and
seventy cents and the said Indenture therefore Witnesseth that the said John Tick
being willing and desirous to secure the pay ment of the said debt with the interest thereon according
unto him the said Lewis Worrell hath for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar lawful
Money of Virginia to him or paid him by the said John Barrett Trustee at and before the entering
and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted sold and
assigned unto him the said John Barrett Trustee his heirs and assigns forever the following parcel and
personal property to wit. One certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being the aforesaid
County of Touchampton and Parish of Saint Luke being the land whereon the said John Tick
now resides containing by a late survey thirty three and four tenths acres to the same more or less and bounded
by the lands of Henry Wray and dec^d Lewis Nickens John Haysen right of his wife et al being the said
John Nickens proportionable part of the land of this father Jordan Nickens and one griststone
two son of mow and one bay filly and their increase twenty four head of hogs and three concave and
pan cart wheel seven head cattle brook sheep and their increase To have and to hold the above
mentioned property both real and personal unto him the said John Barrett Trustee his heirs and
assigns forever and the said John Nickens for himself his heirs Executors administrators and assigns
both hereby covenant and agree to and with the said John Barrett Trustee his heirs Executors
administrators and assigns that he well by these presents warrant and forever defend the right
and title of the above named property hereby conveyed or intended to be hereby conveyed and every
part or parcel thereof against the claim or demand of all and every Person or persons claiming
Up on Specialties Nevertheless To and for the following intents uses and purposes
that is to say that the said John Barrett or his legal representatives may and shall at any
time hereafter being thereunto requested by either the said Lewis Worrell or John Nickens or either of
their legal representatives convey and shall convey unto Lewis Worrell or his legal representatives
herein the said Lewis Worrell shall at public auction for ready money all the aforesaid
