 bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell also to confirm same  
 to said Benjamin Bunn his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land sit-  
 uate lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and parish of St. Luke's con-  
 taining thirty acres by a late survey to be the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit  
 Beginning at a pine a corner for Sams and Socul Neck alter a new corner for William Story  
 thence along the said Socul Neck; thence \$30 E 9 $\frac{1}{2}$  poles to a cedar tree thence 52.5 E 18 poles
