This Indenture made and entered into this twentieth day of April eighteen hundred and twenty nine between Henry Barron and Rebecca his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Robert J. Musgrave of the County and State aforesaid of the other part. Whereas it is agreed for and in consideration of the sum of fifteen hundred dollars to the said Baron in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Baron. the said Henry Barron and Rebecca his wife have granted bargained and sold unto the presentee do grants bargained and sold unto the said Robert J. Musgrave and his heirs forever all right between and confirm unto the said Robert J. Musgrave and his heirs forever the same tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton State aforesaid it being the whole of the land of which the said Baron is proprietor and on which he now resides containing five hundred and forty acres more or less to be described as follows. Beginning at a corner on the road in Bodg or's Branch down southward to Cox's Swamp down this swamp to a corner in two tramps 29 p. 118 ft. to a pine in Burnell Murphy's line A 8. 10 103 p. to a hick oak cor. of Murphy's line A 82 & 83 b. p. to a dead pine in the horse meadow. A 82. 83 b. p. to a red oak 72 ft. p. to a pine corner of vacant land. A 17. 6 14 p. A 37. 6 12 p. A 9 11 16 p. to a pine tree of Edward & Barron. A 80 2. 111 10 8 p. to the horse meadow down said meadow it meanders to Angelica Swamp thence up the same in course of said swamp to a willow below the Mill House whence A 15. 11 14 8 p. to a small red oak thence 231 poles to a pine on 84 rods old. no ad. A 65. 11 14 11 p. to the ground beginning with all the improvements and appurtenances and privileges thereto belonging thereunto and to hold unto the said Robert J. Musgrave his heirs and assigns forever which said land we the said and above named Henry Barron and Rebecca his wife do warrant and defend the title of to the said Robert J. Musgrave and his heirs forever against the claim or claims of every person whatsoever. I now almyers by these presents that we Henry Barron of the County of Southampton and William Peters of the County of Suffolk are held and firmly bound unto Robert J. Musgrave of the County of Southampton in the sum of fifteen hundred dollars for and in consideration of the money of Virginia to which payment will and truly to be made us we bind ourselves his true administrator and assigns. The condition of the above obligation is such that whenever above bound Henry Barron has sold to the said Robert J. Musgrave the tract of land on which he now resides containing five hundred and forty acres and has received a sum the same to the said Musgrave bearing date. Now if Rebecca Barron wife of the said Henry Barron whom she shall arrive at lawful age shall relinquish all her right of dower or other interest in said land then the above obligation to be void otherwise to remain in full force and virtue In Testimony whereof we have hereunto set our hands and affixed our seals this 20th April 1829
