To Jonathan Boyne of the County of Southampton of the one part Richard Onens of the said County of the same  
part and Exum Turner of the said County of Southampton of the third part witnesseth that whereas the  
said Jonathan Boyne stands greatly indebted by Bond to the said Richard Onens in the sum of twenty  
Pounds Current Money of the United States of America and whereas for the further appearance of the  
same to Exum Turner

payment it is agreed by the parties hereto that a conveyance in Trust shall be made to the said Exum Turner  
for the benefit of the said Richard Onens in case the said Bond shall not be punctually paid off with  
lawful interest thereon or before the fourtide day of June next. This Indenture witnesseth  
that the said Jonathan Boyne for and in consideration of the premises and for the further sum of five  
dollars to him in hand paid the receipt of which is acknowledged and acknowledged by the  
present doth for himself his heirs Executors & Administrators give grant bargains and sell unto the  
said Exum Turner his heirs and assigns all that part of my land adjoining to Exum or Boyne's  
Carr Boxes and Alesha Boyne containing seventy five acres and bounded as follows and  
also all the buildings wodwaters and water course and appurtenances to same in any way  
belonging and the reversion remainder and reversionary profits thereof and all other rights of time  
the said Jonathan Boyne of and to the same are excepted and have all therof to have and  
to hold the above granted and bargained premises notwithstanding any agreement to the contrary  
Exum Turner his heirs and assigns in Trust forever and it is hereby declared to be the true  
intent and meaning of these presents that if the said Jonathan Boyne shall punctually  
pay unto the said Richard Onens his heirs or assigns the sum of twenty dollars  
and interest payable to the Tenth of said Bond to the said Richard Onens then the  
said Exum Turner his heirs and assigns shall hold the said land above granted to the sole  
and proper use and behoef of the said Jonathan Boyne and the said Exum Turner  
Covenants and agrees with the parties hereto that in case the said Jonathan his heirs Executors  
and Administrators shall fail to make payment to the said Richard Onens his heirs and assigns or or before the  
fourth day of June next the sum due on the bond aforesaid that then the said Exum Turner his heirs &  
assigns shall stand seised of the above granted and bargained premises for the purpose following that  
is to say that at the request of the said Richard Onens his heirs Executors & Administrators and  
assigns he the said Exum Turner his heirs Executors and assigns or either of them shall give twenty  
days Notice and sell at public sale the above mentioned tract or parcel of land and that paying  
the money arising therefrom to the said Richard Onens his heirs Executors & Administrators & assign  
so forth as shall be then due and (less paying the said sum of interest and all the expenses of surveying)  
or remaining from the notice and sale shall pay the said money to the said Jonathan  
Boyne or his assigns In witness whereof the parties hereto have set their hands
