This Indenture made this 13 day March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty nine between Charles Harrison and Nancy his wife of Southampton and Jane of Virginia of the one part and William Brew of the County and State of Virginia of the other part Witnesseth that whereas the said Charles Harrison and Nancy his wife for and in consideration of the sum of fifty four dollars to them in hand paid by the said William Brew the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged each bargained sold conveyed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell convey and confirm unto the said William Brew of the County and State of Virginia a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County aforesaid State aforesaid and bounded by a late survey eight ten acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows (viz) by the lands of the said William Brew Humphrey Dwyer and the said Charles Harrison on the one side and to hold the said bargained land and premises with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining unto the only proper use and behoof of the said William Brew his heirs and assigns forever and the said Charles Harrison and Nancy his wife do for themselves their heirs and assigns in grant and forever defend the land and premises against the right title claim or interest of all and every other person or persons whatsoever In Witness whereof we the said Charles Harrison and Nancy his wife have hereunto set our hands and seals the day & date above written signed sealed &c
