

Southampton County In the Clerk's Office the 21st April 1829 This Indenture made by Benjamin Morrell of the first part Edmund Thorpe of the second part and Jacob Barnes of the third part of which parties are of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia whereas the said Benjamin Morrell standeth jointly indebted to the said Edmund in the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars by bond bearing date with this Indenture here added or demand the payment of which together with the interest which shall accrue thereon the said Benjamin Morrell are willing in consideration of the sum of six dollars current money of the United States to him in hand paid by the said Edmund Thorpe at and before the execution and delivery of these presents to have receipt whereof hereby acknowledging and from any part of which the said Edmund Thorpe and all his legatees representatives are forever released and免除 of his charge & having granted bargained and sold and delivered by this present grant bargain and sell unto the said Edmund Thorpe his heirs and assigns as follows that is to say the said Benjamin Morrell have granted bargained and sold and do hereby grant bargain and sell unto the said Edmund Thorpe his heirs and assigns the following named property to wit Two steamer beds & furniture one painted Chest six chairs two tables Two sets one desk over and pay pan one spin wheel case Trunk and Forked Shovel one Coal bin two geat and horn and four iron axes one Tommey two carts one hand cart wheel one barrel iron & cold water keg Sheep one sow and six pigs and four head cattle To have and to hold the above named property and every part and parcel thereof to him the said Edmund Thorpe his heirs executors administrators and assigns forever and trust nevertheless that if the said Benjamin Morrell or any other person shall well and truly pay to the said Jacob Barnes his executors administrator or assigns the aforesaid sum of one hundred and fifty dollars with interest which shall have accrued thereon or before the same may be shall be required by the said Jacob Barnes his executors or assigns that then this Indenture and everything herein contained is to be void and of none Effect but if the said Benjamin Morrell nor any other person shall or does not pay the aforesaid sum of one hundred and fifty dollars together with the interest which shall have accrued thereon or before the said Jacob Barnes his executors administrator or assigns may or shall require the same then upon the request of the said Jacob Barnes his executors administrator assignee the said Edmund Thorpe shall money sell and dispose of all or so much of the above named property as shall be sufficient to pay and discharge the aforesaid debt of £150.00 the sum to be sold at public auction for ready money at the dwelling house of the said Benjamin Morrell agreeing at least the day previous public notice of the time and place of such intended sale by advertisement posted up in at least three public places in the aforesaid County of Southampton and that the proceeds of such sale after paying and discharging all costs and expenses the Execution of this Trust to be applied by the said Edmund Thorpe to the discharge of the aforesaid sum of one hundred and fifty dollars due and owing as aforesaid or so much thereof as may then be due including interest and any surplus of money thereafter remaining in the hands of the said Edmund Thorpe shall be paid over to the said Benjamin Morrell or his heirs and in case the said Edmund Thorpe shall die before the execution of this Trust his executors or committee shall carry this Indenture into effect according to the said Benjamin Morrells last will and testament with the said Edmund Thorpe
