& This Indenture made and entered into on the 20th day of April 1856 between and between Benjamin Worrell of the first part Edmund Thorpe of the second part and Jacob Barnes of the third part all of which subjects are of the county of Southampton in the State of Virginia whereas the said Benjamin Worrell stands indebted to the said Jacob Barnes in the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars by bond bearing date with this Indenture pay able or demand the payment of which together with the interest which shall accrue thereon the said Benjamin Worrell are residing in and himself consents to appear and answer to the said Jacob Barnes notwithstanding this Indenture with respect that the said Benjamin Worrell as well in consideration of the premium as of the sum of one dollar current money of the United States to him in hand paid by the said Edmund Thorpe at and before the executing and delivery of these presents the full receipt whereof he hereby acknowledges and from any part of which the said Edmund Thorpe and all his leg or representatives are forever released and discharged and he charges & charges and is charged and is bound by these presents grants bargains and sells unto the said Edmund Thorpe his heirs and assigns as follows that is to say the said Benjamin Worrell have granted bargained and sold and do hereby grant bargain and sell unto the said Edmund Thorpe his heirs and assigns the following named property to wit three feather beds and furniture one painted chest two chairs two tables two iron one bedstead one iron stove one spin wheel case frame and fork three ploughs one cow one goat and two ewes four ponies one horse two cattle one pair and whole one sorrel mare & a colt seven head sheep one sow and the pigs and four head cattle to have and to hold the above named property and every part thereof unto him the said Edmund Thorpe his heirs and assigns forever and all the right and interest and Estate which the said Benjamin Worrell has had or lawfully had and to the above described property and every part and parcel thereof to him the said Edmund Thorpe his heirs and assigns immediately and assign forever in Trust nevertheless that if the said Benjamin Worrell or any other person shall well and lawfully pay to the said Jacob Barnes his Executors administrators or assigns the aforesaid sum of one hundred and fifty dollars or the interest that shall have accrued thereon on or before the same may or shall be required by the said Jacob Barnes his Executors or assigns that then this Indenture and everything herein contained is to be void and of no effect but if the said Benjamin Worrell nor any other person shall or does not pay the aforesaid sum of one hundred and fifty dollars together with the interest which shall have accrued thereon on or before the said Jacob Barnes his Executors administrators or assigns may or shall require the same then upon the request of the said Jacob Barnes his Executors administrators assigns the said Edmund Thorpe shall not may sell nor dispose of all or so much of the above named property as shall be sufficient to pay and discharge the aforesaid debt & interest the sum to be sold at public auction for ready money at the dwelling house of the said Benjamin Worrell giving at least ten days previous public notice of the time and place of such intended sale by advertisement posted up in at least three public places in the aforesaid county of Southampton and that the proceeds of such sale after paying and satisfying all costs and charges the Ecclesiastical of this Trust be applied by the said Edmund Thorpe to the discharge of the aforesaid sum of one hundred and fifty dollars and as much as aforesaid or so much thereof as may then be due including interest and any surplus of money then after remaining in the hands of the said Edmund Thorpe shall be paid over to the said Benjamin Worrell or his or her and in case the said Edmund Thorpe shall die before the execution of this Trust his Executors or committee shall carry this Indenture into effect & operation by this said Benjamin Worrell doth covenant to and with the said Edmund Thorpe
