This Indenture made this 18th day of May in the year of our Lord
Eighteen hundred and twenty nine between James Cooper and Araminta his
wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part
and Emma B. Bland of the County and State aforesaid of the other part witnesseth
that the said James Cooper and Araminta his wife for and in consideration of
the sum of Seven Thousand and forty Nine dollars to them in hand paid by the said
Emma B. Bland the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained
and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Emma B.
Bland a certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County and State aforesaid
and on the South side of the Three Creeks and bounded as follows beginning
at a small plumt tree at the head of the said Cooper's line turned along its
line A 713 E 160' pole to two dogwood and dead black Jack a new corner
for said Cooper an Benjamin Williamson's line thence along his line South 53°
W 160' pole to a black gum standing on a branch thence up the said branch to a marker
thence a line of marked trees S 13° 44' W 160' pole to a post oak
thence S 16° 44' E 160' pole to a small white oak a corner for the said Williamson
Other at 9000' thence along the said Williamson's line N 89° E 160' pole to a corner for
the said E 160' line thence along his line S 89° W 22° 30' pole thence South 34° 30'
pole thence S 85° 3' W 28' pole thence S 17° E 2' pole thence along the said
line ad. S 85° 3' W 12' pole thence S 11° 3' W 44' pole to a post oak thence a line of marked
trees S 16° 23' W 87' pole to a post oak and dogwood thence S 30° E 89' pole to a plumt bush
